

LogicQuest Joint Venture Awarded Air Force Eglin Wide Agile Acquisition Contract (EWAAC)

LogicQuest LLC, a joint venture (JV) with managing member nLogic teamed with large business member LinQuest Corporation, has been selected for an Eglin Wide Agile Acquisition Contract (EWAAC) award from the U.S. Air Force. The ten-year, multi-award indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity contract has a ceiling of \$46 billion and covers pre-program activities, technology development, engineering and manufacturing, and production. Work under the contract will be done at Eglin Air Force Base, Fla., which hosts the Air Force’s test and evaluation center for air-delivered



weapons, navigation and guidance systems, command and control systems, and the service’s special operations systems. Customers include the Air Force Life Cycle Management Center Armament Directorate (AFLCMC/EB), the Air Force Research Lab (AFRL), and the Air Force Nuclear Warfare Center (AFNWC).

The primary objective of EWAAC is to provide rapid response applicable to all areas and lifecycle phases of weapons development to include weapons concepts, concept development, concept demonstrations, weapons system procurement, production, fielding, operations, and sustainment to quickly meet current and future weapons system requirements. “The Air Force has been moving toward greater agility in acquisitions since they unveiled their 30-year strategy in 2014.
